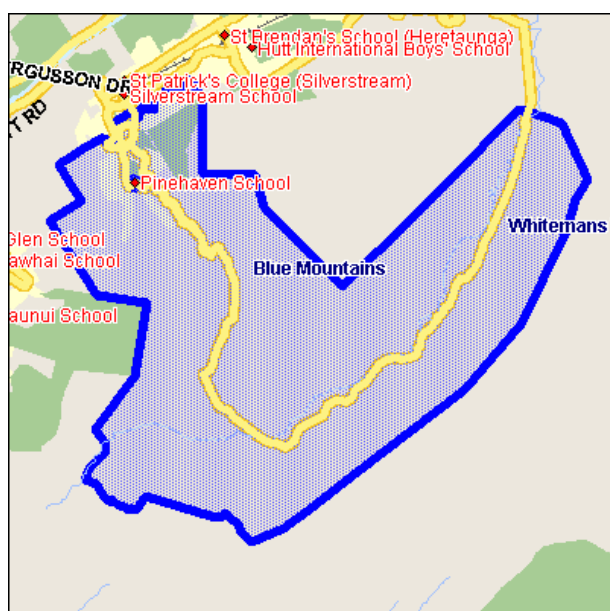


Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below and shown on the attached map are entitled to enrol at our school. Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

- Chatsworth Rd, including Kenilworth Grove, Ashdown Way, Arundel Grove and Raynham Way.
- Blue Mountains Road to Whitemans Valley Road and all roads going off Blue Mountains Road, including Sunbrae Drive.
- All side streets off Sunbrae Drive, including Deller Grove, Tapestry Grove, Clinker Grove, Ecclesfield Grove, Dunrobin Grove, Glenrae Grove, DunCraig Street and Dunleith Grove.
- Whitemans Valley Road and all side roads to, but not including, Katherine Mansfield Drive.

Out of zone enrolments

Each term the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following term for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a community newspaper circulated in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for out of zone enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

<u>First Priority</u>	will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
<u>Second Priority</u>	will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
<u>Third Priority</u>	will be given to applicants who are children of board employees.
<u>Fourth Priority</u>	will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with Ministry of Education instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
