## 2025 Enrolments

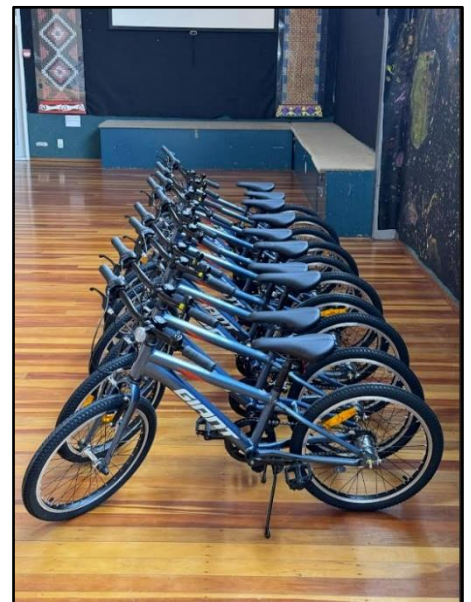
